



Thank you for bringing to our attention that the letter sent to Spectrum Academy on November 18, 2008 did not contain the correct amendment request information. This letter should replace the previous letter and is to inform you that the Utah State Board of Education's intended action in its November 7, 2008 meeting approved the requested amendment to the charter of Spectrum Academy. That amendment added grades 9 - 12 and increased enrollment by 128 for a maximum allowable enrollment of 338 students beginning with the 2010-2011 school year.

Subsequently, the Utah State Board of Education took action in its May 7, 2010 Board Meeting approving the most recently requested amendment to the charter of Spectrum Academy. This amendment increases future enrollment by 220 students for a maximum allowable enrollment of 558 students beginning with the 2011-2012 school year.

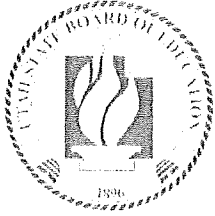
2014-2015	Grades K-8, 384 students

This letter is to inform you that the Utah State Board of Education took action in its August 8, 2014 meeting approving the requested amendment to the charter of Spectrum Academy. The amendment is to modify Spectrum Academy's charter agreement to increase enrollment by 48 students at the Alpine campus beginning in the 2014-2015 school year.

As this expansion neither adds 20 percent or more new students nor two or more grades served during a single school year, the school is not eligible for a significant expansion adjustment under Board rule R277-479, *Charter School Special Education Student Funding Formula*.
