Team Responsibilities:

- As a member of a team, you are required to give your absolute best in each and every Practice and Games
- You are there to support your teammates and help them learn and grow as athletes and individuals
- Athletes will NOT interact with the referees under ANY circumstances.
- Athletes are expected to interact with members of opposing teams with respect and the guiding principles of Spectrum Academy's PRIDE rules.

Grade Expectations:

- 2.5 GPA with no grade lower than a C-. If a player does not meet these qualifications, they cannot participate in practices or games until the academic requirements are met.
- Students are expected to send their updated grades every Monday throughout the season to their coach in order to participate in that week's practices/games.

Behavior Expectations:

- All student-athletes are expected to be leaders and examples to their Spectrum Academy peers. They are to exemplify the PRIDE Rules each and every day and in everything they do.
- Any situation that requires the administration to become involved with student discipline will also require team discipline. The terms of the team discipline will depend on the student's behavior and will be decided on by the basketball coaching staff and school administration.
- Unexcused absences (non-medical) during game days mean that you cannot play in the first half of the game. Players must be present for 3 of the 5 class periods on game days in order to play in the game.
- You must be present for 3 of the 5 class periods to participate in practice.
- Any unexcused tardies during the school day require you to run during practice.
- Any full-day suspension is an automatic 2 game suspension and no practice until after the second game.
- Any partial-day suspension is an automatic 1 game suspension and no practice until after the game
- If a student is suspended from a game, they must be dressed in a collared shirt and present at the game(s) to support their teammates. The suspension is not counted until the student is present at the game(s) and dressed in a collared shirt.

Administrative Section:

- An athletic participation fee of \$90 should be paid before the 2nd game so your Student-Athlete can compete in games.
- Players must be picked up after practice ends by a parent or guardian. Coaches can stay until 15 minutes after practice if needed.
