Panther Club

What is Panther Club?

Panther Club is a recreational child care resource offered to Spectrum Academy families to provide a safe, structured environment for your children before and/or after school. Please note that this program does not provide any educational services and is separate from Spectrum Academy.

How is Panther Club funded?

Panther Club is self- funded through the fees charged for the service. In order for Spectrum Academy to continue to provide this service, it is vitally important that Panther Club statements are paid in a timely manner. If an account is 60 days past due, Panther Club privileges may be revoked until the account is current or suitable arrangements have been made. This allows us to pay for adequate staffing to ensure appropriate supervision of participants. Note: You have 30 days to dispute a fee.

There is an initial deposit of \$50.00 per family payable at the time you submit your student(s) to attend. The deposit cannot be used for monthly payments throughout the school year. However, it can be applied for the final fee with your June statement, or it can rollover to the next year. Additional details regarding fees are included in your Panther Club Agreement.

What can my child bring to the Panther Club?

Your students can bring their own personal <u>labeled</u> electronics (Personal electronic devices) for use only when they are in the club. Also, in order to limit noise levels earbuds and or headsets are required. Please note all games or sites must be school appropriate and are at the discretion of the staff.

We ask that all personal toys or collectable trading card(s) be left at home and will not be allowed at the club(s).

What does Panther Club Cost?

The fee for Panther Club that you will be billed is \$5.00 per hour (Prorated) for the First child from your family, \$4.00 per hour for each additional child. Family Participants are billed by order of arrival time. Participants needing supervision of a level of 3:1, will be billed at a rate of \$8.00 an hour.

When and where is Panther Club available?

Panther Club is available for all participants in the morning from 7:30 a.m. until the start of school. Drop off prior to 7:30 is not permitted, as there is no staff to supervise children until that time.

Panther Club is available for all participants in the afternoon from the end of school until 5:30 p.m. Mon-Thurs, and 4:00 p.m. Fri and Early out days. There will be a charge of \$1.00 per minute for any participant not picked up by 5:30 p.m. M-Th and 4:00 p.m. Friday and Early out days.

- Grades K-6 will be located in the Elementary School Gym
- Grades 7-12 will be located in the High School Gym
- STARS building K-12+ will be located in STARS Gym

Please note that the school is locked during Panther Club hours. To pick up your child, please call the Panther Club number found on the front door of each school. A staff member will bring your child to you.

What are the safety policies for Panther Club?

For the safety and well-being of all Panther Club participants, any participants who consistently create an unsafe environment, we have a 3-incident policy, may not be allowed to attend Panther Club. Panther Club staff will communicate with parents regarding any unsafe or disruptive behavior and make every effort to resolve concerns. If unsafe or disruptive behavior continues, Panther Club privileges will be revoked either temporarily or permanently, depending on the severity of the behavior. Additional details are included in the Panther Club Policies and Agreement.

What about COVID?

While we make every effort to provide a safe and clean environment, there are currently no specific COVID restrictions in place. Any future restrictions which may be required for schools by the State of Utah will carry over to Panther Club. If your child has an elevated temperature or is otherwise unwell during Panther Club you will be contacted to pick them up as soon as possible.

Do I need to send a snack with my child?

We ask parents to donate <u>individually packaged snack</u> items that will be provided to children during Panther Club. If your child has specific dietary needs, please provide their snacks separately. Snacks typically donated by parents include cookies, chips, gold fish, fruit snacks, granola bars, small waters, juice, etc.
